GCYS Player responsibilities

- Represent the Soccer Club in a positive way.
- Conduct yourself with class and dignity on and off the field.
- Must bring a ball, shin guards, water, and a great attitude to learn and train hard to each and every training session. No Shin guards, No Play.
- Attend and be prompt to all training sessions which are crucial in the development process of a player. Attendance is MANDATORY.
- Must respect all officials, referees, administrators, trainers, and coaches and accept their decision without questions. Must respect above all parents.
- Give encouragement to your fellow teammates.
- Observe the rules, policies and procedures of the Team and Club.
- Take pride in yourself, your family and the club as much as you can.
- You are responsible for your own fitness level. In order to maximize your performance levels, you must be fit. Two training days per week is not enough.

Parents Responsibilities

- Be supportive of your child with positive reinforcement.
- Respect the coach's and referee's decision.
- Do not coach during the match from anywhere at the field.
- Take pride in yourself, your family and the club as best as you can.
- The club and the coaches will not tolerate indiscretions and embarrassments at games and tournaments.
- Consider and agree to the financial commitments of the team and club. This includes registration fees, training fees, uniform fees, tournament fees and other soccer related fees.

0 Tolerance

As GCYS player, you must accept and abide by the rules, policies and procedures set forth by the Team and Club. Serious infractions may warrant the immediate removal from the team and club of the offending player for the following reasons:

- Drug, alcohol, and tobacco use.
- Violence, abuse, profanity and dishonesty.
- Verbal and/or physical harassment and/or confrontation with referees officials, administrators, teammates, trainers, coaches, spectators and opposing players and staff members before, during and after training sessions and soccer matches.
- Parental behavior that brings serious disrepute at games and tournaments and disregard of GCYS policies and regulations can also lead to the immediate removal from the club of the parent and/or player.

We believe behavior is crucial to team success or failure. The GCYS coaching staff will not permit a destructive behavior that will undermine the team's morale and performance. We have high expectations for our coaching staff, the club, your parents and you.
